The District of Hope Fire Department was formally created in 1999 with the amalgamation of the Kawkawa

Lake; Flood, Laidlaw, Silver Creek; and Hope Volunteer Fire Departments. Today these three fire halls serve the municipality and surrounding areas providing fire suppression and emergency response as well as public education and safety training. The department consists of one paid Fire Chief along with volunteer firefighters. Firefighters practice weekly on Thursday nights and new recruits are accepted once annually in the fall as needed.

The programs that we run are:

- 1) the traditional Big Brothers Big Sisters Program. In this, a child aged 6 to 13 is matched with a volunteer Big Brother or Big Sister who sees the child once a week for 2 to 3 hours. They do low/no cost activities, have fun, share interests, and learn new skills. The children are primarily from single parent families.
- 2) In-School Mentoring (ISM) Program in which a child usually in grade 2, 3 or 4 is matched with a Big Buddy who meets with the child for one hour each week at the school, during school hours but not in the child's classroom. They play board games, do crafts, bake, build things, read, whatever they both enjoy doing together.
- 3) Between Generations program is expected to start in January 2008. This is like the ISM program above, but matches the child with a senior aged 55+.
- 4) Big Bunch/Group Activities. These are monthly events to which children on our waitlist for a Big Brother/Sister are invited. They include outings to the waterslides, the Chilliwack corn maze, swimming, hikes, etc.
- 5) An annual camp each Fall.

Any parent or teacher or community member may refer a child to the program, but the parent's approval is required and the child must be interested in the program.

We welcome new volunteers for any of the programs: Big Brothers and Big Sisters, In-School Mentoring, and Big Bunch Group Leaders.
